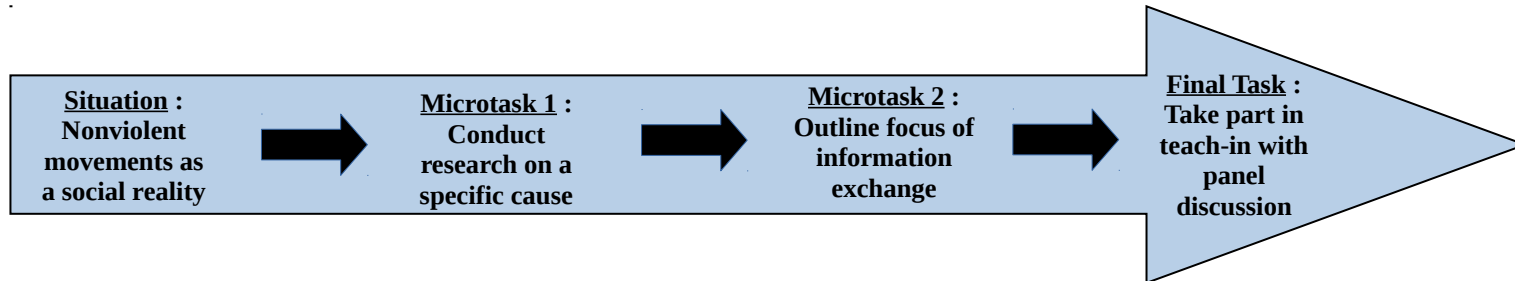


Civil Disobedience and Nonviolent Direct Action

1	Microtask 1 (research)	Quest documents ; authentic documents selected by students	Reading comprehension ; collection of information related to topic (semi- guided research)	Completion of quest document through both individual and group work	PC, internet, search engines, online dictionaries
2	Microtask 2 (synopsis)	Flyers	Written expression ; synthesis of information from research	Write a synopsis (150-200 words) to highlight the main points of the cause to be discussed	PC, internet, justpaste.it
3	Macrotask (discussion)	Program	Oral expression ; introduction and discussion	Introduce oneself in character ; participate in panel discussion ; interact with the public	Vocaroo, audio files
